Course Overview :

- This 12-14 month course is comprised of a written examination, practical examinations and a workplace portfolio (Record of experience)
- The awarding body for the National Certificate for dental nurse qualification is the National Examining Board for dental nurses (NEBDN.) Tempdent is an accredited NEBDN training centre.

How do I book on to the course?

You will need to attend an enrolment at one of our Training Centres, where your Literacy skills & levels will be assessed via a 20 minute Level 1 Basic Skills assessment. All experienced dental nurses will also need to sit a 15 minute Dental Initial Assessment in order to assess your existing level of dental knowledge.

You will then have a 1:1 interview with a member of our training team who will then provide successful applicants with a course acceptance letter.

For unsuccessful applicants we will always provide you with relevant Information Advice & Guidance to address the issue i.e. if your Literacy levels are not at a level 1 we can place you on our [ESOL course](#) & then accept you onto the dental nursing course once you are ready.

Course fees

- £720 plus VAT experienced class for all [eligible](#) candidates
- £750 plus VAT non experience class for all [eligible](#) candidates.
- £1500 plus VAT for all learners non [eligible](#) candidates

You will also be required to pay an exam fee to take the National Certificate exam. The exam fee is currently £175

You will be required to pay a minimum deposit of £200 for all Home students and £400 for all Overseas students, at least 2 months before the start of the course, in order to secure your place.
