Certificate in Dental Radiography

Course Overview

The Certificate in Dental Radiography post-qualification course is certificated by the Society and College of Radiographers who are the trade union and professional body for the diagnostic imaging and radiotherapy workforce in the UK: https://www.sor.org/about-us

Upon successful completion of this 9-month course, you will possess the knowledge and skills to take intra-oral and extra-oral radiographs without the supervision of a practitioner.

Course Structure

The Record of Experience consists of signed and verified Practical Competence Observation Reports completed by the practitioner in the taking of 26 radiographs to include at least:

- Seven Dental panoramic
- Seven pairs of bitewings
- Twelve paralleling technique for periapical radiographs (Posterior & Anterior)

In addition, you will also have to complete:

- Two supplementary projects
- Eleven formative assessments
- Technical Exam 40 Trues & False Questions and 10 Extended Multiple-Choice questions

Delivery of Course:

The course will run over 9 months and the delivery will be online via a Webinar by a qualified Radiography Teacher. You will be required to attend 2-hour live webinars every 3 weeks as well as accessing further learning through our Online Radiography content platform.

Examination:

The examination may be completed online





Entry Requirements

You must be a General Dental Council registered professional.

Your dentist must be willing to allow you to take a variety of radiographs for patients and to supervise you throughout your course. They can refer the supervision to a suitably qualified registrant such as an associate dentist, therapist, hygienist, dental nurse or any medical person who holds a dental radiography qualification.

You must have regular access to a computer or laptop and the internet to undertake this online course.

Intakes

The course typically starts every April and October.

Delivery model: 2-hour live webinars every 3 weeks supported by our online Radiography content platform and the completion of an online record of competence (ROC)

Enrolment Process

You can enrol either online or over the telephone.

You will be required to complete an application form online and provide a copy of your GDC registration certificate. Your supervising employer will need to sign a consent form to agree to you to complete the course under their supervision.
